

INTERNALIZZAZIONE

Globalization requires people to increase their range of knowledge, awareness and measures to develop new skills, essential elements to relate better to the challenges of an increasingly complex society whilst providing answers.

The Department of Civil Engineering, Energy, Environment and Materials, on the basis of directives issued by the governance of the University and by the Pro-Rector of International Relations, gives great importance to the mobility of teaching staff, research and students, with an internationalization of the goals it sets out to develop. This can be achieved through the encouragement of certain activities such as offering specialized courses, allowing foreign students to conduct research for their theses, the conferring of degrees and improving services offered to international students.

The establishment of partnerships and academic exchanges between students and the teaching staff with prestigious foreign universities is of the utmost importance. These relationships are established through agreements stipulated in the general interest of the University which can be generic (Memorandum of Understanding) or negotiating (Framework Agreement of International Cooperation and Protocol Implementation) and may involve different types of activities.

The type of procedure varies according to the purpose of the agreement and the host nation abroad.

The care of the above is now entrusted to the "Internationalization" Department, the aims of which can be summarized as follows:

- Further developing the relationship of the Department with universities, institutions and foreign and international entities in order to foster cooperation and partnerships in the fields of research, education and training;
- Increasing the mobility of teachers and students, including post-graduates;
- Giving advice and support to teachers interested in entering into international agreements
- Providing support both for the students of the Department who want to spend a period of study at a university abroad (outgoing) and foreign students who want to spend a period of study at our department (incoming);

The aforementioned body also aims at promoting initiatives which may help foreign students to settle in and also provide career guidance for them.
